ARCHBISHOP'S MESSAGE



I was in Prison. . You visited me

1. Concern for the Prisoners

Chapters 24 and 25 of the gospel according to St. Matthew contain the eschatological discourse of Jesus. The first half of this discourse is doctrinal and the second half of the discourse contains **moral exhortations**. **"Watch** therefore, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming" (Mt. 24:42). "You also must be **ready**; for the son of man is coming at an hour you do not expect" (Mt. 24:44). The disciples should be always **vigilant** and **watchful**, **ready** and **prepared** for the coming of the Lord. **Vigilance** means above all a life of love and mercy, care and concern, solidarity and service, fidelity and commitment to one's duty.

The last part of the last discourse contains the description of the last judgment (Mt. 25:31-46). This universal judgment means the final reckoning, the separation of the Good and the August 2018

bad, eternal life and eternal damnation. What will be the criterion of this judgment? Or, in the light of the last discourse of Jesus, what does it mean **to be watchful**, **ready** and **faithful**? To be watchful means to be able to **recognize Jesus** in all persons who are in need; **to be ready** means to be loving Jesus in these people. To be **faithful** means to show this love concretely by service to them and solidarity with these needy people.

In the gospel pages we read that Jesus had identified himself with the poor, the needy and the marginalized. Whatever good we do to them, we do it to Jesus himself; whatever good we do not do to them, we do not do it to Jesus himself. Recognizing Jesus in the poor and the needy and serving them brings us eternal salvation. Not recognizing Jesus in the poor and the needy and not serving them leads us to eternal, damnation. Our salvation or damnation depends on the works of love and mercy.

Feeding the hungry, quenching the thirsty, welcoming the stranger, clothing the naked, visiting the sick and the prisoners (Mt. 25:35-37) are the works of mercy which decide our eternal happiness or eternal punishment. When we see the face of Jesus in these people and serve them, we are blessed with eternal peace and joy. When we neglect the poor and the needy, when we are insensitive to the needs of the people and when we fail to serve them, we are cursed to eternal damnation.

These works of mercy are the concrete expressions of our love and concern for the poor and the needy; The central message of Jesus is love and love should be concretely expressed in actions. "Little children, let us not love in word or speech, but in **deed** and in **truth**" (1Jn. 3:18). The works of mercy are the concrete expressions of our faith (cf. Jam. 2:17).

The final judgment of Mt. 25:31-46, is based on the centrality of the person of Jesus. Jesus is the criterion of Judgment and He is the judge. Since Jesus had fully identified himself with the poor and the needy, with the marginalised and the oppressed, the works of mercy done to them, are really done to Jesus himself. Neglecting the poor and the needy, the marginalised and the oppressed, is neglecting Jesus himself.

On 12th August 2018, we are celebrating the **Prison Ministry Sunday.** This celebration should help us to take the works of mercy seriously. When we make a visit to the prisoners, with whom Jesus has identified himself, we are visiting Jesus himself. On this day let us pray in a special way for all the prisoners in our country. The prisoners are not cases to be studied; they are not problems to be solved; they are not questions to be answered. They are **human persons** to be loved, accepted, respected and to be served. Let us visit our brothers and sisters who are imprisoned. Let us pray for their families and support them emotionally and financially. Let us generously make financial contribution for the formation and education of the children of the prisoners. Let us also work for the speedy release of the prisoners.

St. Theresa of Calcutta saw the face of Jesus in the poor and the needy, in the suffering and the oppressed in the lonely and the abandoned and served them lovingly and willingly. Thus, she quenched the thirst of Jesus, hanging on the cross. Following her example, let us love the poor and the sufferings and serve them for the sake of Christ.

2. Youth Sunday

This year 5th August will be celebrated as the **Youth Sunday.** The youth are the hope of the nation and of the Church. On this day let us all pray in a special way for the youth in our country that they may have proper formation and education and become responsible citizens of our country and members of our Catholic Church.

3. Day of Mourning

The constitution (Schedule Caste) order 1950 was signed on 10th August 1950 by the then President of India which says that **"No person who professes a religion other than Hinduism shall be deemed to be a member of the Schedule Caste"** which was later amended to include Sikhs (1956) and Buddhists (1990) in the Scheduled Caste net.

This order discriminates the Dalit Christians. Hence, we observe 10th of August as a **Day of Mourning** and demand that Dalit Christians be constitutionally granted Schedule Caste status.

There will be a public meeting on the 10th August 2018 at Uzhavar Sandhai, Managaratchi Maidanam, Thennur, Trichy from 04.00 p.m. to 08.00 p.m. Thousands of Dalit and non-Dalit Catholics will take part in this big gathering to demand constitutionally S.C. status for the Dalit Christians and Dalit Muslims. From our Archdiocese we are arranging 10 buses (one bus from each vicariate) to transport the participants to take part in this important meeting. Rev. Fr. A. Arputharaj, the Secretary of our Archdiocese SC/ST Commission is making all the necessary arrangements for this very significant gathering.




Prayerful Greetings to you from the Archdiocesan Charismatic Renewal Commission Puducherry.

Since the health condition of Fr. S. Peter was serious, he was admitted at the Nallam Clinic on 09-06-2018 and was treated. Since he was in a critical state Archbishop Most Rev. Anandarayar visited him on 13-06-2016 and Fr. S. Peter was anointed that evening.

On 10-07-2018 at 04.00 p.m. the news came from Nallam Clinic that Fr. S. Peter was serious. So the Vicar General and the Procurator rushed to the clinic at 04.30 p.m. and prayed for him. That night at 01.15 a.m. (11-07-2018), Fr. S. Peter went for his eternal rewards at the Nallam Cinic. Then at 02.30 a.m. his body was taken to Emmaus Retired Priests' Home, Colas Nagar. The retired Priests blessed and prayed around his body. At 06.00 A.M. the retired Fathers offered the Mass for the eternal rest of Fr. S. Peter. At 07.45 A.M. the body of Fr. S. Peter was taken by an ambulance to the St. Patrick's School, started by Mr. Regis his brother and managed by Fr. S. Peter's nephew Mr. Regis John Britto. There, the staff and students prayed around the body of Fr. S. Peter. Then at 11.15 a.m. Fr. S. Peter's body was taken from St. Patrick's school and reached the Bishop's House at 11.30 a.m. Then the Archbishop Most Rev. Dr. A. Anandarayar blessed the body of S. Peter and with the Fathers recited a rosary and offered it for his eternal rest.


