Archbishop's Message



Following Christ More Closely

All the Christians, by virtue of their baptism, are consecrated to **follow Christ**, to be the **disciples of Christ**. By virtue of their confirmation, all Christians are called **to be witnesses to Christ**. The Religious, through the profession of the evangelical counsels of **chastity, poverty and obedience**, are **totally dedicated** to God and **follow Christ more closely** (Can. 573).

The Religious are called to follow Christ more closely:

- Christ, **the Poor**
- Christ, **the Chaste**
- Christ, **the Obedient**
- Christ **Praying**
- Christ **Proclaiming the Gospel**
- Christ **doing good to the people**

- Christ in **dialogue with the people**
- Christ **always doing the will of the Father**.
(Can. 577)

“Blessed are the poor in Spirit”. (Mt. 5:3), “Blessed are you poor” (Lk. 6:20). “If you would be perfect, go, sell what you possess and give to the poor . . . and come, follow me” (Mt. 19:21). Poverty, poverty in spirit, total detachment from wealth is an essential requirement to follow Christ more closely. The poor are those who are totally dependent on God, on divine providence for everything. The Religious, by living a life of radical poverty, are called to be configured with Christ the poor and to bear witness to Christ the poor.

Religious life is more a matter of **being** than doing; it is more **relational** than functional. The religious are called to be **with Christ, for Christ and like Christ**. The religious are **consecrated persons**. Consecration is for mission. The religious are consecrated for the mission of Christ. The religious cannot carry on the mission of Christ effectively and efficiently, unless they are in deep communion **with Christ** through deep prayer life and live **like Christ** through a life of poverty and simplicity.

Christ “was **rich**, yet for your sake he became **poor**, so that **by his poverty** you might become **rich**”. (II Cor. 8:9). Christ “emptied himself taking the form of a servant” (Phil: 2:7). From his birth to death, from the crib to the cross, Jesus lived in utter poverty. Jesus wants the religious to walk in his footsteps, leading a life of poverty and simplicity.

A life of poverty is an essential element in the life, ministries and services of priests and religious. St. Francis of Assisi identified himself with Christ, with the poverty of Christ in the crib and on the cross. Many religious congregations have taken St. Francis of Assisi as their father, patron and model. What is predominantly striking in the life of St. Francis of Assisi is his life of **radical poverty**, total dependence on God. All the religious are called to bear witness to Christ the poor by a life of radical poverty.

This life of poverty takes us closer to the poor people in the society. Christ associated himself in a special way with the poor, the sinners and the outcaste (Lk. 15:2). We are exhorted to “remember the poor” (Gal. 2:10) in a special way, to share our riches with the poor generously and to serve the poor cheerfully. Pope Francis repeatedly reminds us that the church is **of the poor and for the poor. Who we are to the poor** is more important than what we do for the poor. Following the example of Christ, let us identify ourselves with the poor. We should always keep in mind that **being with the poor** is more important than **doing for the poor**. We wish and pray that all the religious **be poor, be with the poor and be for the poor** in our society.

Every year on 2nd February we celebrate the feast of the Presentation of our Lord in the temple. This day is observed as the day of consecrated life. We offer our prayerful wishes and congratulations to all the Religious in our Archdiocese. By their consecrated presence, by their exemplary lives and dedicated

services, they make significant contribution to the growth of our Archdiocese.

Mary carried Jesus in her arms to the temple and offered him to God. Through the hands of Mary, let us all -priests, religious and the laity in our Archdiocese – offer ourselves to God.

VOICE FROM METROPOLITAN MATRIMONIAL TRIBUNAL- 100**1. Report of the 28th Annual Meeting of Tamil Nadu Canonists' Association**

The 28th annual meeting of TNCA, held on 21st and 22nd January, 2019 at TNBCLC, Tindivanam. It began with the invoking of the Holy Spirit, Bible reading, prayer and the lighting of the Kuthuvillakku led by Rev. Fr. Pudumai sdb, Fr. S. Pascal Raj, Fr. Angel Raj, Fr. Alagu Selvam, and Fr.M. Philomindoss. The President welcomed the resources persons and the participants. Fr. Alagu Selvam welcomed and introduced the Chief Guest. The key note was addressed by Rev. Fr. Pudumai sdb, Rome and emphasized on 'Mismanagement of Ecclesiastical Goods: Some canonical considerations' on the screen. He presented with clarity and wider understanding on the present scenario how it affects the Catholic Church and as a next bomb shell awaited as Church Scandal.

After the tea break, Fr. Xavier Benedict presented on Building the Church in India in collaboration with the Oriental Churches' as now the situations arising more for discussion than argument. The afternoon session, Fr. Louis Ruban, ofm,cap., prepared the paper on 'the process of Exclaustration and grounds for dismissal of religious' and in absentia read out by Fr. Thomas, msfs, Rome and Fr. A. Rayappan clarified the doubts. Fr. W. Gerge Vincent highlighted on 'Totius Consortium Vitae' (canons 1055 §1 [CIC]; 776 §1 [CCEO]) and the recent updates were lacking. Fr. Angel Raj, TNCA, Vice President celebrated Holy Mass in the evening before supper. There were lots of interactions, doubts and clarifications in every session. It lasted for some time for a fruitful discussion.

On 22nd January 2018, Fr. S. Pascal Raj, TNCA President celebrated the Holy Mass. Fr. Charles Kumar dealt on 'the subtle difference between the application of c.1095, 2°,3°, in the marriage cases'. Fr. A. Alagu Selvam, dealt on the 'recent canonical updates'. After the tea break, Fr. 1. Artists form a National Dalit Christian Artists Forum

A three day Dalit Christian Artists workshop was held from 18 th to 20 th January 2019 at Indian Social Institute, Bangalore. Around 17 Dalit Christian artists from different parts of India, belonging to various denominations, participated in the workshop. Fr. Devasagayaraj, and Fr. They insisted that the arts should not only bring out the pathetic reality of the Dalits should also bring out the faith aspect as a Christian value of Hope which is one of the core values of Christianity.
