"In those days Mary arose and went with haste into the hill country, to a city of Judah and she entered the house of Zachariah and greeted Elizabeth (Lk. 1:39-40).

Mary, our beloved mother, is the first one to hear the gospel; she is the first one to receive the gospel; she is the first one to proclaim the gospel to others.

The gospel is that Jesus Christ, Son of God is born in Bethlehem as the SAVIOUR of humankind. As soon as Mary conceived Jesus in her womb, she is filled with the joy of the gospel. She went with haste not only by the movement of her feet but above all by the movement of her mind and heart to share the joy of the gospel with Elizabeth, her cousin. the womb of Elizabeth leaped for joy as soon as she heard the greeting of Mary.

The gospel of great joy is announced to the shepherds. They went with haste to Bethlehem and found Mary and Joseph, and the babe lying in a manger. They spoke to others about the child. They glorified and praised God for all they had heard and seen (cf. Lk. 2:10-20). The shepherds heard the gospel; they saw the gospel and they proclaimed the gospel.

The pilgrim church is missionary by her very nature (AG.2). The Church exists in order to evangelize. Evangelization is the vocation proper to the church (cf. E.N.14). Our Christian vocation is essentially a missionary vocation. For us nothing is more essential, more important, more urgent than the most important work of evangelization. We are called to proclaim the gospel both by word and deed, by preaching and by the witness our exemplary Christian life.

Mary is the Mother of the Church; she is the model and guide for the mission of the church. She is the "Star of Evangelization". Mary went with haste to share the joy of the gospel with Elizabeth. Do we have the same sense of haste, of eagerness, of willingness and of readiness to share the joy of the gospel with the people around us? Do we take time and make efforts for the proclamation of the gospel? Let us always keep in mind that the most sacred work of evangelization is the most important thing in our lives. With Mary and like Mary, our dearest mother, let us carry the Lord Jesus

Amix of all these states of life makes the family inclusively a happy one, though none are free from problems, suffering, worry and pain. Genuine mutual love and suffering are inseparable companions in family life. As in all vocations, growing and maturing in the family within its natural setting is the deepest need. And all members have to work at the maturing. All will have to learn to love; i.e, living for the 'other' rather than for the self. Husband has to learn the needs of the spouse, both physical and psychological (the needs of children, too). The greatest need is to be recognized as a person, loved and respected; to be told that she or he is loved.

The young and old will have to learn how to talk together as equals, to discuss problems. Each has to learn to listen; recognize one's faults and failures and work at overcoming them. In a word, all need to communicate as growing youth and mature adult, those not yet married, need to prepare themselves spiritually, physically, and financially as well. They will have to keep up their lives' goal and aspire to achieve it in the light of a true Christian spirit.

This month Our Archbishop is going to have an inaugural ceremony declaring the decree of the convocation of the Synod. So, please act fast and send the questionnaires to me.
Synod: Our Archbishop gave a short but precise history regarding the First Synod (1884) and $1^{\text {st }}$ (Nov. 1992) and $2^{\text {nd }}$ (Nov. 2014) livein programmes during our Priests' recollection in December on $12^{\text {th }}$ 2018 and gave the final list of the Topics that we are going to discuss during the $3^{\text {rd }}$ Synod of Pondicherry 2019. ## Action Plan:

1. The Secretaries of the concerned Commissions in charge prepare the questionnaire, the purpose of which is to bring forth from the people their concerns in each field.
2. Inaugural celebration and declaring the decree of Convocation of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ Synod of Pondy 2019.
3. Core Group and Steering Committee of the Synod are to finalise the questionnaire to be sent to the parishes.
4. At the parish level, form a Synodal Committee to distribute the questionnaire to all the organizations of the parish and collect and co-ordinate the answers and make a report to the vicariate centre.
5. VF's should form a vicariate synodal team consisting of Priests, Religious and the Laity to collect the parish Synodal reports and coordinate and give a vicariate report to the Secretariat.
6. Selection of the experts who will deal with the each group of topics and give us a presentation of these topics in writing, making use of the data from the reports, teachings and traditions of the church basing everything on the scriptures.
7. Archbishop, with the knowledge of Senate and College of Consultors, will instruct the Core Group and the Steering Committee to decide the Synodal members, the dates, number of days, number of sections, venue of the Synod and other programmes and procedures of presentation and different committees to be formed to conduct the Synod.

So Dear Fathers, all these will be informed to you continually in due course of time. Please act and respond in time as we plan out. 2019 is very important for our diocese. Let us involve totally and make our Diocese to be always a pioneer and model to the Church of Tamilnadu, India and the world at large.

Senate: Dear Fathers, we conduct 3 meetings of the Senate in a year that is one in 4 months. So the first meeting will be held sometime from January - April. Usually we conduct at the end of February. So please when you have vicariate meeting this month or next month please collect the suggestions from the vicariate Fathers.
