

Dear Rev. Fathers, Brothers, Sisters and Lay faithful,

Joy of Pain!

Richard H. Smith, an American professor, authored a psychological book in 2013, The Joy of Pain: Schadenfreude and the Dark Side of Human Nature. He narrates how people easily admit to taking pleasure in the misfortunes of others. But at the same time they enjoy it when an arrogant but untalented contestant is humiliated. The truth is that joy in someone else's pain, recognized by the German word schadenfreude, permeates our society. But, there is also an opposite side, in that we take pride in our own suffering: severe pain and torture of mind and body, even agony of death. This is the situation seen in Paul when he says: "I am now rejoicing in my sufferings for your sake" (Col 1:24). What prompted this transformation from schadenfreude and selfpity to rejoicing over pain and suffering? The answer is seen in Jesus' encouraging words to us: "In the world you face persecution. But take courage; I have conquered the world!"

(Jn 16:33). This is the transformation brought by Jesus who conquering the cross of death brought the victory of Resurrection.

Resurrection: A Drastic Transformation!

The Persians and later the Romans used the wooden cross to execute the death punishment and thus erase a person from this world. However, this could not become a reality in the case of Jesus of Nazareth. Although there is a myth in the ancient Greek religion that Asclepius, after being killed by Zeus,

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resurrected, achieving an immortal existence, the historical reality of conquering death and attaining eternal life is seen only in Jesus Christ. Indeed, the historicity of the resurrection of Jesus could very well be established by the Gospel-accounts of the empty tomb and the apparition narratives. Nevertheless, there appeared the hypotheses that Jesus did not die on the cross, that the empty tomb was the result of Jesus' body having been stolen, or that Jesus was never entombed. But there is a unanimous consensus among biblical scholars that the Gospel accounts are not a result of myth but are a kind of ancient biography (E. P.Sanders, "Jesus Christ," *Encyclopedia Britannica*, 2007).

This reality of Jesus' transforming death to life, a drastic break-through from a cross of torture to a Cross of New Life, is unequivocally attested by the solid belief of early Christianity, spelt out by Paul: "For I handed on to you as of *first importance* what I in turn had received: that Christ died for our sins...and that he was raised on the third day in

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accordance with the scriptures" (1 Cor 15:3-4); again, he confirmed that the last enemy destroyed by Jesus was death (1 Cor 15:26; cf. Heb 2:4). Peter also encouraged the Christians: "Jesus was put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit" (1 Pet 3:18).

Fear of Death Abolished!

It is to be asserted that Jesus not only destroyed death but also eradicated the fear of death. Indeed he had already said: "when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw all people to myself" (Jn 12:32). On account of their belief in Jesus the early Christians were tortured, put behind bars and even put to death. The Risen Lord told them: "Do not be afraid; I was dead, and see, I am alive... and I have the keys of Death and of Hades" (Rev 1:17-18). Jesus taught us that death is not an end, but only a change of life (First Preface of the Mass for the dead). This belief pervaded the veins of Peter and John who proclaimed, ignoring any threat to life, "we cannot keep from speaking about what we have seen and heard" (Acts 4:20). 'If the dead are not raised,' Paul asks, 'why should I have stood every day at the door of death and fought with wild animals (adversaries) at Ephesus? What have I gained?'(1 Cor 15:31-32). This belief was strong even among the pious Jews, so much so that the fourth sibling of the mother of the seven children told his persecutors: "One cannot but choose to die at the hands of mortals and to cherish the hope God gives of being raised again by him" (2 Macc 7:14). This is the strength of Jesus' Resurrection and the secret of martyrdom witnessed even today.

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Resurrection Continues!

Jesus' Resurrection is not only a historical fact of one unique happening but a continuous event in our life, an everyday event. Jesus did not rise from the dead for his own sake but for us all, showing his power over death and evil, his love for the whole creation (Rom 8:21) and his merciful sharing of the same new life which we can experience and manifest in every moment of our life. On account of the Easter experience Paul was able to bless when reviled, endure when persecuted, and speak kindly when slandered (1 Cor 4:12-13). Easter gives us joy of pain; changes scourging, thorns and nails to a hope-filled life of solace, peace and happiness. Easter reveals the face of God who rejoices in sacrificing his own Son for those who are sinners and the heart of Jesus who "gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God" (Eph 5:2). Through our courageous witness to this Risen Lord, we shall transform the tortures of Good Friday into the joys of Easter Sunday!

Wish you all a Joyful Easter! May the Risen Lord fill your heart with his grace of newness!

New Apostolic Nuncio to India

His Holiness Pope Francis has appointed **Most Rev. Leopoldo Girelli** (68), until now Apostolic Nuncio to Israel and to Cyprus, and Apostolic Delegate to Jerusalem and Palestine, as the new

Apostolic Nuncio to India. This provision was made public on Saturday, 13 March 2021 at 4:30 p.m.

Archbishop Leopoldo Girelli was born on 13 March 1953 in Predore, Bergamo in Lombardy region of northern Italy. He was ordained priest on 17 June 1978 for the diocese of Bergamo. He holds a doctorate in theology and master's degree in canon law. He entered the diplomatic service of the Holy See on 13 July 1987 and worked in the Papal Diplomatic missions in Cameroon, New Zealand and at the Section for General Affairs of the Secretariat of State, and finally in the Apostolic Nunciature to the United States where he held the rank of Counsellor.

Pope Benedict XVI appointed him Apostolic Nuncio to Indonesia on 13 April 2006 and Titular Archbishop of Capreae. He was ordained Bishop on 17 June 2006 by Cardinal Angelo Sodano. He was appointed Apostolic Nuncio to East Timor on 10 October 2006 in addition to his duties as Apostolic Nuncio to Indonesia. On 13 January 2011 he was appointed Apostolic Nuncio to Singapore, Apostolic Delegate to Malaysia and to Brunei, and non-residential Pontifical Representative for Vietnam. He was also appointed Apostolic Nuncio to the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) on 18 June 2011.

On 13 September 2017, he was appointed Apostolic Nuncio to Israel and Apostolic Delegate to Jerusalem and Palestine and on 15 September 2017 he was appointed Apostolic Nuncio to Cyprus. Aside from Italian, his mother language, he also speaks English and French.

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We are pleased to welcome our Nuncio, Archbishop LeopoldoGirelli, to India and wish him every grace of the Almighty that his mission will be successful and enhance the Indian Church with her living witness to Christ!

Gentle Reminders!

1. Holy Week Services

Taking into consideration the unusual situation of GOVID-19 in our Archdiocese Priests are reminded to main COVID protocol in conducting the services of the Holy week.In particular, take special care in Washing the Feet on Holy Thursday and allowing people to kiss the Holy Cross on Good Friday.

2. Accounts

Keeping accurate and update account is a serious duty and responsibility of the Parish Priests and Heads of the Educational Institutions (cf.Can.1284). All the parish priests and the Heads of the Institutions are reminded of this serious responsibility and asked to submit the accounts of the financial year 2020-2021 to the procurator on or **before 30th April 2021.** Accounts are to be submitted to the procurator and all the accounts will be audited only by our Archdiocesan auditors.

Information

1. Summer Ministry to the Seminarians

Taking into consideration the extraordinary situation of COVID-19, and having regular classes in the seminary **till 30 April 2021**, this year **there is no summer ministry to the seminarians.** They can remain in their respective parishes, help the parish priest and stay with the parents. At the end of their one month vacation, parish priest of the respective seminarian is requested to send a report to the diocese which will be sent to the seminary.

2. Status of Some Priests

The present status of the priests of the following Dioceses and congregation is provided hereby:

1.Mr. C. Jayakumar - a former priest of Diocese of Ootacamund.

He was ordained for the diocese on $1^{\rm st}$ May 2013, has been laicized with immediate effect by the Apostolic See. He has been reduced to the state of laity.

2. Fr. S. F. Victor - a former priest of Diocese of Ootacamund

He was ordained for the diocese on $21^{\rm st}$ April 1993, incurred a *lataesententiae*suspension for having attempted marriage (canon 1394 no.1). his priestly faculties are removed with immediate effect. He has been admonished to apply to the Holy Father to seek dispensation from priestly obligations including the obligation of celibacy.

3.Fr. D. Maria Selvam - a priest of Diocese of Vellore

He was ordained for the diocese on 16th April 2016, incurred a *lataesententiae* suspension for having attempted marriage (canon 1394 no.1). He has been admonished to apply to the Holy Father to seek dispensation from priestly obligations including the obligation of celibacy.

4.Fr. Savariraj Arputharaj MMI

The society of Missionaries of Mary Immaculate suspended him from exercising priestly ministry on 15^{th} February 2020 according to canonical prescriptions.

He was actively promoting a particular party from celebrating Holy Mass in different places against the canonical rules. He is a priest under suspension.

Hereby I direct you all not to invite Fr. S.F. Victor, Fr. D. Maria Selvam and Fr. Savariraj Arputharaj MMI for any priestly ministry in your parish, institutions and in religious houses. The Christian faithful are hereby advised not to approach them for the exercise of their priestly ministries.

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Voice from Metropolitan Matrimonial Tribunal – 124 Who is a Good Leader?

A Leader is a person who directs guides and influences the work of others in attaining specified goals. A good leader includes Integrity, Accountability, empathy humility, resistance vision, influence and positivity, good ideas, quick thinking and decision making is the best qualities of a leader.

A successful leader gains more credibility in the eyes of people, they often tend to ignore other deficiencies in him/her. They resolve to adhere to him/her and allow themselves to be further exposed to his/her influence.

Leaders who relate their power with responsibility in a consistent manner are more successful in their influence than the others. In short, effective leaders direct the activities of an organization towards the attainment of the specified organizational goals. The main source of motivation of a leader is the motivating power to group efforts. In order to motivate the subordinates for higher productivity, effective leadership is needed. Leadership creates confidence in the subordinates by giving proper guidance and advice. The leader derives his power from the group members.

Discipline refers to the performance and good examples of a role model leader. A leader of national or international standing commands widespread influence over a large number of people while the influence of the leader of a small work group in an organization is very limited. Both are leaders in their own right. The leader is in a position to shape, regulate, control and change the attitudes, behavior

and performance of his group members. There exists a particular relationship between the leader and his group members which is characterized by interpersonal and social interaction. The leader has a few bases of power by virtue of which he is in a position to influence the behaviors of group members. And we do not have enough space to maintain individual / social distance in our prayer hall where we can only accommodate not more than 100 persons according to the directives of the government. So until our next announcement there will be no Third Saturday Prayer Meeting in our Centre.

Christhuvar Vazhurimai Iyakkam

A diocesan team comprising of the office bearers of various commissions and the diocesan administrative bodies attended a one day high level meeting of Christhuvar Vazhurimai Iyakkam and Legal Cell of the TNBC, on 20th Saturday at Trichy. And we have decided to send a circular to all our Parishes and Congregations to have a clear vision of the situation and our stand in the present day political scenario of the Central and State governments. We have really and objectively analyzed the situation with the help of Professor Devasagayam and Rev. Fr. Xavier Arul Raj, the Senior Counsel in Madras High Court by their enlightenment sessions.

We clearly came to a conclusion that at present the Central Government's fundamental option is to demolish the basic structures of our democracy foreseen and protected by the sacred constitution of our Nation i.e. the pluralism in India, the federal structure of the Indian Nation and the secularism of our country.

So this election for the legislative assemblies of the four states and one union territory is of a great value to the ruling central government. They are in a draconic majority in the Lok Saba and Raj Saba where they can pass any law with the power of the majority dictatorship. So today in the centre we have a democratic autocracy.

So they want that by all means that they are in power in the state assemblies as well in the union territory, either by becoming the ruling party or be a part of the ruling coalition by which they can dominate and impose any law which are anti-democratic, anti-constitutional anti-poor because of their absolute majority and power in both the houses.

So in the states and union territories, we should elect a party who can uphold the constitution of India, that respects and protects the state government's quasi autonomy, the secular character of the country and who can challenge the religious fundamentalism and take strict measures against those who are perpetrating bloody clashes on the basis of religion, and also who works for the protection of ethnic and cultural histories of the states. The elected ruling party of the states and the union territory should work for more autonomy of the states in the fields of education, culture, agriculture, transport, medicine, health care and taxation of the people and they should respect also the historical traditions of the states and their contributions towards the building up of the nation.

The elected party should be able to fight against the centre for more independence to develop the people of the states and up hold their culture and tradition by shifting more matters from the list of the centre either to the list of the state or the concurrent list so that certain amount of freedom is enjoyed by the states and union territories. So we have no other option except to support the alliance which is contradicting the central government and that which can win

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the elections and form the government. So accordingly, the Parish Priests are encouraged to study the local situations under these above mentioned parameters and prudently enlighten our people to understand the political situations and freely exercise their democratic responsibility without being carried away by caste, political parties or individuals.

Conference of the Diocesan Priests of India (CDPI)

Last month we had the National Council Meeting on 25th of February of which I have already given the details, we had a Virtual meeting over Google meet facility. Around 75 Priests from all over India were on the screen floor. We were having two input sessions based on "Fractelli Tutti" and we have concluded the meeting with a resolution of creating brotherhood among our Christian people and also among the people of the world.

Now on 25th March, we will have a virtual National Executive Meeting and evaluate our activities and plan out our next National Meeting in February 2022 and share our regional activities of the CDPI.

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Death and Funeral of Fr. M. Lourdusamy

Fr. M. Lourdusamy was suffering from Dementia i.e. Loss of memory and judgement for the past 2 years. He also had acute diabetes and heavy cholesterol. He was treated for all these. On 01-03-2021 around 06.00 a.m. Fr. P. Jegaraj saw him sitting on the chair in his room. At 07.00 a.m., when Sr. Selvi, the Superior went to the room, she found him dead on his bed. At 02.00 p.m. the Fathers of the Emmaus Retired Priests' Home, Colas Nagar offered the mass for his eternal rest.

At 03.15 p.m. on 01-03-2021, the body of Fr. M. Lourdusamy was brought to the Bishop's House. Then, Most Rev. Dr. Anandarayar, Archbishop Emeritus blessed the body and then the fathers here and the relatives of Fr. M. Lourdusamy recited a rosary and offered it for his eternal rest. Then the religious Sisters of different Congregations came and prayed. Throughout the night his relatives kept vigil around his body and sang and prayed. On Tuesday his former Teachers from St. Antony's, Mel-Nariappanur, R.C. Teacher Training School, Tindivanam, St. Mary's, Karaikal and his former parishioners from Mel-Nariappanur, St. Francis Xavier's, Villupuram, Anaiyeri came and paid their respect and prayed for his eternal rest. Fr. A. J. Philomindoss the Director of the Pastoral Centre, co-ordinated all this.

At 10.50 a.m. Most Rev. Dr. Peter Abir, the Apostolic Administrator blessed the body and the body was taken through the corridor to the Cathedral. At 11.00 a.m. the Apostolic Administrator offered the funeral mass. Most Rev. Dr. Anandarayar and 49 priests concelebrated. Very Rev. Fr. A. Arulanandam in his introduction said that Fr. M. Lourdusamy out of his 83 years, 55 years lived as a Teacher and Parish Priest. He introduced Jesus to others. He dedicated himself for this. Most Rev. Dr. Peter Abir in his homily said, "we thank God for Fr. M. Lourdusamy and pray for his eternal life. Out of his 83 years of his history, 1/3 of his life, he spent as Christ's servant.

I had regular contact with him from Tindivanam. I had met him in his Ministry places. He had challenges. அவரில் பொறுமை, நிதானம் என்ற நல்லதொரு கிறிஸ்துவ, குருத்துவ பண்பினைப் பார்க்கின்றோம்" Sirach says that in our lives, all our actions are in front of God. God sees everything. He doesnot leave out anything. He will pour out their reward on their head. St. Paul in his letter to the Corinthians says: 'I believe that I will live with Him. Since I have that hope, we are hopeful that I will live, inspite of all dangers. That is the reality of life. St. Ignatius of Antioch said: "Men are born; they die. God's saints are born and they are continuing to be born". The Book Revelation says: "We are born, we die. This is nature. When we live by God's power, we will not attain the second death i.e. Hell. This is what St. Paul said: "போற்றுவோர், போற்றுதலும், தூற்றுவோர் தூற்றுதலும் எனக்கு ஒரு பொருட்டல்ல. வாழ்வும், சாவும் என்னை பாதிப்பதில்லை. ஏனெனில் நான் கிறிஸ்துவின் பணியாளன்", God's life, we

already live. This is what St. Ignatius of Antioch meant when he said: we are born but, we don't die". All the challenges cannot drown us. This is what David said: Even if I should walk in the valley of darkness, no evil would I fear. The Lord will not abandon me". He will give eternal life. He will pour the reward of eternal life on us.

Let us pray that Fr. M. Lourdusamy may enjoy that life. With that hope, let us say "Good Bye" to him. At the end of the mass Fr. John Peter, the nephew of Fr. M. Lourdusamy, the present Parish Priest of Subramanyapuram, Trichy, thanked the Bishops, the Procurator and the Sisters for having taken the best care of his uncle. He also praised his uncle for having been his role model to become a Priest. After the Mass Most Rev. Dr. Anandarayar, Archbishop Emeritus did the commendation prayers and blessed the body at the Cathedral. The teachers, the old students of Fr. M. Lourdusamy carried the body to the adjacent graveyard and Most Rev. Dr. Peter Abir, the Apostolic Administrator did the final blessing. And then the body of Fr. M. Lourdusamy was laid to rest.

May His Soul Rest in Peace.

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Fr. J. Paul's body was laid for visitation at the Fred H. McGrath & Son, Funeral Home, Bronxville between the hours of 2 to 6pm Sunday February 28, 2021. Most of the New York Archdiocesan & Indian and FIHM Priests sisters (Pondicherry) participated in the



prayer service with hymns, spontaneous prayers and Eulogy. Around 400 people from his previous three parishes- St. Gregory Harrison, St. Barnabas Bronx & St. Joseph Bronxville visited and paid their last respect and some offered the Mass Cards. Even his friend-priests, some former students of Petit Seminare and relatives travelled a long distance came and shared their memories of Fr. Paul.

As it was broadcasted nationally and internationally in social media, many viewed it virtually. His nephew, Joe Balthazar's family was physically present at those hours. The parishioners with tears met Joe and shared Fr. Paul's good qualities, spirituality, talents, commitment and availability. Our diocesan priests, Fr. Bernard & Fr. Edison and FIHM sisters assisted the people to observe the Covid-19 norms. The visitation ended with the hymn Salve Regina.

Funeral was at 10am Monday March 1st 2021, St. Joseph's Church Bronxville New York. The closed casket was brought from the funeral home to the church. Most Rev. Edmund J. Whalen, one of the five bishops of New York

Archdiocese was the main celebrant. Homily was given by Fr. Dawson Ambosta (native of Mumbai, New York Archdiocesan priest and friend-priest of Fr. Paul). In it he mentioned that Fr. Paul was a 'bridge in troubled waters', meaning Fr. Paul was a bridge to many people who had a troubled life.

At the end of the mass Fr. Peter McGeory, the pastor said as follows. 'Time was tough for us here at St Joseph's. We had to say goodbye to our dear Fr Paul. What an impact he made on our parish in less than 18 months! We were uplifted, however, by the prayers of over 50 priests who joined us at Mass and over 2000 who prayed with us virtually.

I shared this story at today's funeral. Last Sunday after the 10:45 Mass, a young family with 4 children asked if I could chat with them about the death of Fr Paul. Some of the young ones were really feeling his loss. As we sat together, I asked them what they loved about Fr Paul. One of them said, "he was kind." Another said, "he was smart." Yet another commented, "he was holy." The fourth youngster said, "he was happy." We talked a little more and together we offered a prayer for Fr Paul. As they were leaving, I gave them a picture of Fr Paul to take with them to remember him. FIHM sisters (Pondy) sang a Tamil funeral hymn at the end of the Mass.

Without knowing it, these 4 youngsters gave the perfect tribute to Fr Paul. A priest of God, who selflessly served people for over 40 years in both India and the United States. Yes, he was kind, smart, holy, and happy. This is how we will

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remember him. May Fr Paul rest in peace and continue to watch over us from his new heavenly home'.

After the mass and final service, the body was carried over to a private cremation center.

On 21-03-2021 Sunday at 05.00 p.m. the Urn with the Ashes of Fr. J. Paul was brought to the Archbishop's House by his siblings Mr. Rheeman, Mr. Peter and his sisters. Most Rev. Dr. A. Peter Abir, the Apostolic Administrator blessed the Urn. Many of his relatives and the old students of Petit Seminaire and Pope John Paul II College came and paid their respect and prayed for his eternal rest. Throughout 22-03-2021 Monday and on 23-03-2021 forenoon, the Urn with the Ashes of Fr. J. Paul was displayed in front of the Parlour of Archbishop's House on a decorated altar. The Principal, staff and students of Petit Seminaire (where he had worked for 17 years) and Pope John Paul II College of Education (where he has worked for 10 years), and the old students came and kept flower garlands and wreaths and prayed for his eternal rest. Fr. A. J. Philomindoss, the Director of the Pastoral Centre was animating and organising all these. On 23-03-2021 at 10.45 a.m. Rt. Rev. S. Singaroyan, Bishop Emeritus of Salem blessed the Urn and then it was carried through the corridor to the Cathedral. Then Most Rev. Dr. Peter Abir, the Apostolic Administrator, offered the funeral Mass at the Cathedral. Most Rev. Dr. A. Anandarayar, Archbishop Emeritus, Most Rev. S. Singaroyan and 50 Priests concelebrated. The Cathedral was full of the staff and students

of the Petit Seminaire Hr. Sec. School and the Pope John Paul II College of Education, the religious of different Congregations, his relatives and the faithful.

In his introduction Very Rev. Fr. A. Arulanandam said: In 3 days Fr. J. Paul would have celebrated his 72nd Birthday. He is a priest for 43 years. He had realized in his life that God's love is great. God's love in so wonderful. All praise to Fr. J. Paul is a glory to God. He had realized God's love. With hope he spoke from the hospital. He knew each one personally. He knew that the growth of the society depends on the students. So he showed full attention in their lives. We thank God for his Educational Ministry and Social Work.

In his homily Most Rev. Peter Abir said: "The Indian Philosopher J. Krishna Moorthy says: 'Life is a mystery. Death is still more a greater mystery". It is true. Fr. J. Paul was an enthusiastic Priest and friendly to all. He has died due to the cruel Corona. On the 6th February 2021 he was put on ventilator. In the 5th he sent me a message:

"I hope that I will come out well: Still, please pray for me"

The sudden sad news was difficult to accept. The wisdom of Solomon says: "Death was not created by God", St. Paul would say: "Death is the wages of sin". The just man even though he may have untimely death, he will share eternal life. Jesus says: "He who believes me, will never die. He will live for ever . . . I have overcome the death. I am the First fruit". Jesus gives new life. If we die united with Him, we will rise united with HIM. There is the power of new life for us.

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Fr. J. Paul faced many challenges bravely. St. Paul said: "Even if I die, every day I live. Cardinal Martini Commenting on this, says: 'to die in this world is to share in the Resurrection and New Life of Christ already" Let us pray that Fr. J. Paul may share this never ending life.

At the end of the Mass Fr. R. Pascalraj, Principal of Petit Seminaire said: Fr. J. Paul had been the Principal of Petit Seminaire for 17 years.

- 1. The daily test for 10th and 12th students that he started, we continue even today. It is very beneficial to them.
- 2. He started the Archdiocesan Coaching Centre for Engineering and Medical students. Due to his initiative, there are many Doctors and Engineers.
- 3. It was Fr. J. Paul who started the First Computer Centre in Pondicherry. Due to this, many could complete P.G.D.C.A.
- 4. He started the Private Schools' Association to get Govt. Benefits for the staff and students.
- 5. He was a great Administrator. He would insist on **'Hard Work'.** He would plan meticulously and execute.

Many of his old students came and told me: "It is a great loss". We offer our deep felt condolence to the siblings and relatives.

Then Fr. M. Swaminathan, Secretary of Pope John Paul II College said:

"Fr. J. Paul was a great gift of God to the church and to his family. We have to only pray like Job: "you gave, you have taken away: May you be praised" He is a priest for 43 2021

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years. 40 years of priesthood is celebrated in a grand manner in the U.S.A. He invited me to the U.S.A. and we celebrated it together. Out of his 43 years as priest, he spent 17 years at the Petit Seminaire and 10 years at the Pope John Paul II College. He was a great Educationist and an able Administrator. The standard of the Education and how the students have improved and benefited is the criterion. Though young, he was one of the priests who was instrumental to begin the Pope John Paul II College. He was the First Secretary. We cannot separate Petit Seminaire and Pope John Paul II College from Fr. J. Paul. He instilled in the students self confidence. He gave the students தரமான கல்வி, தரமான ஒழுக்கம், தரமான எதிர்காலம். He built the MCA Block with Hall, chapel, MCA Class and Lab. He bought the Wesley School with his influence and used it as Model School. And later, he started the Blessed Mother Theresa School at Nainarmandabam. He started the hostel. Somehow he mobilized the money for all these. The Presence, Impact, Identity of Fr. J. Paul at John Paul College is great. His death is a shock. He sent me a message before his death. With eyes of faith we have to accept this. Prayerful Condolence to his siblings and relatives. He body was burnt. His life has joined the Eternal light".

Then Rt. Rev. S. Singaroyan, Bishop of Emeritus, a class mate of Fr. J. Paul said:

"In 1978, our class mates 36 of us were ordained. 7 have already died. Fr. J. Paul is the 8th. 4 years I studied with him. Although he was 4 years senior to me, because of his Degree studies, he would not show any difference. He was lively and

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a good friend. Although he was in responsible positions, he would not miss our 2 days annual class mates' gathering. We pray for him. He will pray for us.

Then Most Rev. Peter Abir, Apostolic Administrator said:

"In the Minor Seminary I was in the 1st year. Fr. J. Paul was in the 2^{nd} year. From then on, we knew we each other. He was my close friend, not only here but also at Sultanpet. From U.S.A. he helped our diocese at Sultanpet. He would come, all the way to Sultanpet and help me whenever he comes from the USA. His was a witnessing life. My heartfelt condolence to his siblings, relatives, our priests and the old students.

At the end, Mr. Rheeman, the younger brother of Fr. J. Paul and Sherine the d/o. Rheeman said:

"Fr. J. Paul was a special person. To have a priest in the family is a great blessing. He was the most pious in our family. When he was 12 years old, he expressed his desire to become a priest. Our Mother would advise us to be prayerful like him. He was soft, loving, caring and always smiling. He was a great entertainer and a great host. He would call priests: "அதனே!". We accept his departure to Heaven. I thank the Bishops, Priests, Mother Generals, Provincials, Sisters, relatives, well wishers, parishioners, choir, Lourdes T.V., Mercy T.V. for worldwide coverage. He is a role model. Everything that happens is always for the best".

After the mass, Most Rev. Dr. A. Anandarayar, Archbishop Emeritus blessed the Urn after the singing of Liberamé. Then the relatives carried the Urn with the Ashes of Fr. J. Paul and Most Rev. Dr. Peter Abir, the Apostolic Administrator made the ultimate Prayer of commendation and then at 01.00 p.m. the Urn with the Ashes of Fr. J. Paul was placed in the grave dug in the wall.

May the Soul of Fr. J. Paul, Rest in Peace.
