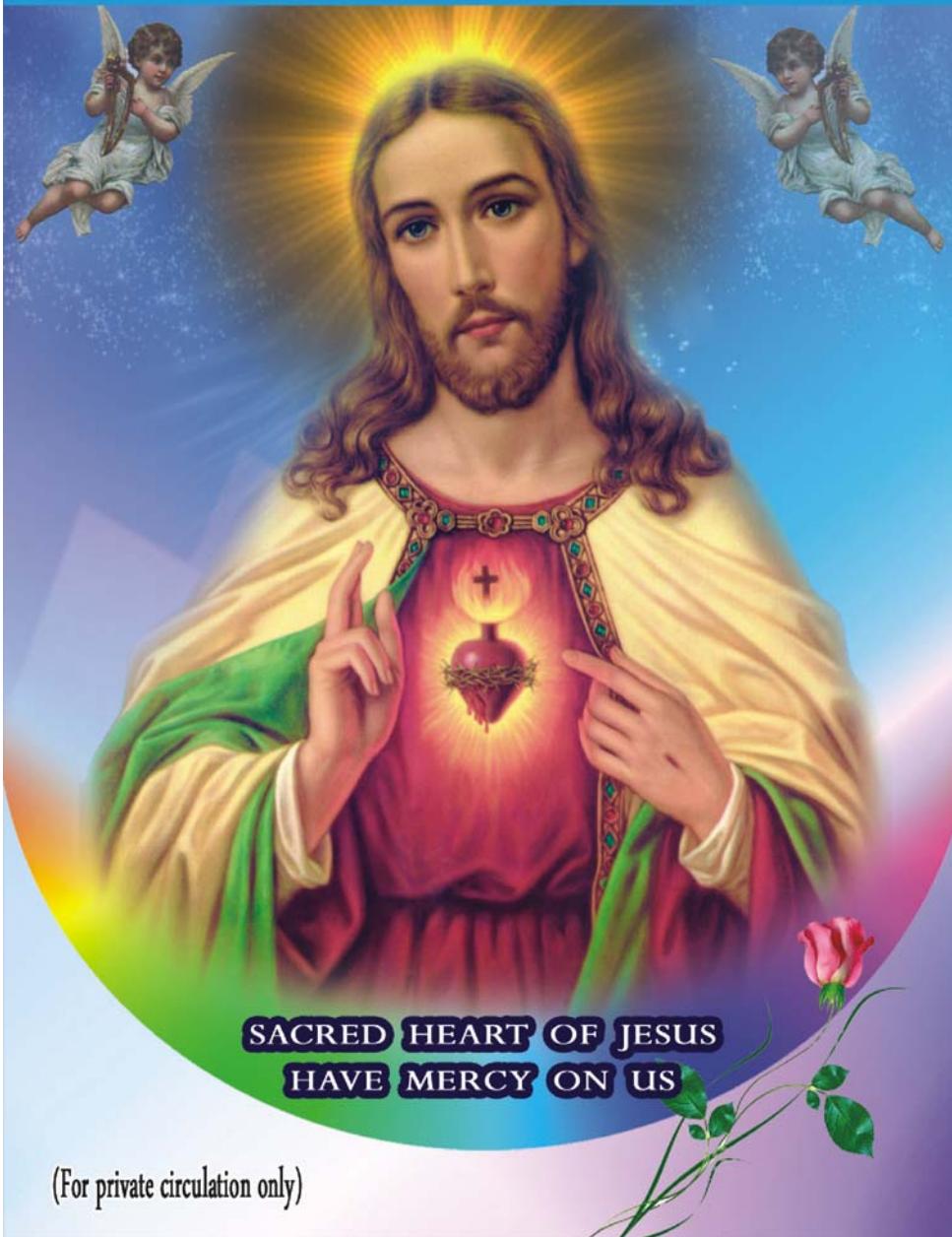

ARCHBISHOP'S MESSAGE



Sacred Heart of Jesus

01. Compassionate Heart of Jesus

On Friday, 23rd June 2017, we celebrate the solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The celebration of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is indeed, the celebration of God's love and mercy, poured on the humanity in and through Jesus. The heart of Jesus is filled with compassion when he sees the people in suffering, in need and in pitiable conditions. He feeds the hungry; he heals every disease and infirmity; he forgives the sinners, he comforts the afflicted.

All the four evangelist speaks about the multiplication of the five loaves (Mt. 14:13-21; Mk. 6:30-44; Lk. 9:10-17; Jn. 6:1-13). Two evangelists speak about the multiplication of the seven loaves (Mt. 15:32-39; Mk. 8:1-10).

Jesus **looks at** people in their concrete life-situations. He **Perceives** the concrete need of the people. "They (people)

have been with me now three days, and have nothing to eat . . . and some of them have come a long way" (Mk. 8:2-3).

This **perception** of Jesus leads him to **compassion**. "I have compassion on the crowd" (Mk. 8:2). Jesus does not want to send away the people hungry to their homes; they may faint on the way. Jesus has not only sympathy for the people but also empathy for them. Jesus suffers not only **with** the people but also **in** the people.

The **compassion** of Jesus leads him to **action**. Jesus wants to feed the hungry people. He wants to involve his disciples in the service of feeding the hungry. The people are in big numbers; the place in a desert. The disciples hesitate, object and protest. "This is a lonely place, and the day is now over; send the crowds away into the villages and buy food for themselves" (Mt. 14:15). "How can one feed these men with bread here in the desert?" (Mk. 8:4). And Jesus said, "they need not go away, you give them something to eat" (Mt. 14:16).

Five loaves of bread and **two pieces of fish** are placed **in the hands of Jesus**. Jesus praises God, blesses the bread and the fish and gives them to the disciples to be distributed to the people. Five thousand men, besides women and children, ate and were satisfied (Mt. 14:20-21). Little things are not little in the hands of Jesus; small things are not small in the hands of Jesus. In the presence Jesus and by the presence of Jesus, miracles take place and wonders happen. The compassionate heart of Jesus feeds the hungry.

We need to have in us the heart and mind of Christ, the dispositions and attitudes of Christ, in order to venerate the Sacred Heart of Jesus in a worthy manner. We should look at all the persons **with the eyes of Christ** and try to understand the concrete needs, desires, problems and difficulties of our people.

We should love all the persons **with the heart of Christ**. We should express our concern for and solidarity with our people especially with the poor and the suffering. "The joy and hope, the grief and anguish of the men of our time, especially of those who are poor or afflicted in any way, are the joy and hope, the grief and anguish of the followers of Christ as well" (G.S. no. 1). There is so much of disease, poverty and hunger around us. Many children daily die due to hunger and malnutrition. Our farmers are suffering a lot. Despair leads many to suicide. Water scarcity is a big problem. Medical facilities and educational opportunities are not easily available to the poor.

Our care, concern and compassion for the people, especially the poor and the afflicted, should lead us into action. We should do something concretely, here and now to help the poor and the sufferings. We should generously share our resources with the poor and the needy.

Those who have received, should learn to give; those who have received much, should learn to give much. We have received much from the Sacred Heart of Jesus let us learn to give much to our brothers and sisters in need.
