Parish Church Built in: 1973

Erected as a Parish in: 1993

Brief History: In the first two or three decades of this century a good many Christians from Eralyur, Viriyur and Maiyanur emigrated to Agarakottalam in search of cultivable lands. By the sixties, there was a sizeable community at Agarakottalam, looked after by the Kallakurichy parish. This became a separate parish in 1993, with Rayapuram, Ranganathapuram and Anaikaraikottalam as substations.



Parish Church Built in: 1938

Erected as a Parish in: 1938

Brief History: The faithful at Chinnasalem were prepared by Fr. Huguet and Fr. Grandjenny since 1933. Chinnasalem became a parish in 1938 with Fr.Peyroutet as the first Parish Priest to look after the vast southwestern area of the Diocese with hardly any Christian presence. The new parish church was built by Fr.D.Savarimuthu.



Erected as a Parish in: 1989

Brief History: Sirupakkam was a small center under Fr.D'Elbreil in 1936 in Kallakurichy Taluk. This was under Chinnasalem till 1954 when Sirupakkam was made a parish with Fr.Pentecoste as the Parish Priest. This parish centre was later shifted to Fatimapalayam, a colony for dhobis founded by Fr.Chauvet. Fatimapalayam was a parish from the year 1989.





OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL CHURCH, KOVILANUR

Parish Church Built in: 1843

Erected as a Parish in: 1967

Brief History: In 1843, Fr.Bardouil set at Kovilanur a centre of the Propaganda, a parish against the Padraoado Konankuppam and slowly brought back all the Christian communities south of Pennar under the MEP. Around 1870, Kovilanur lost its importance as many of its communities became independent parishes and was under Konankuppam till 1967.





Parish Church Built in: 1894

Erected as a Parish in: 1985

Brief History: A center in the 19" century for the dhobis and saklis, first under Salem and then under Attur. Fr.Lazar started to build the church there in 1881. He completed it in 1894 and it became a pilgrim centre. In 1911, this was the centre for the western part of the Archdiocese of Pondicherry, but later Kallakurichy took its place. From 1938, Mel-Nariappanur was under Chinnasalem. In 1985 it became a separate parish. Now it is a famous shrine dedicated to St. Antony attracting huge number of devotees from all religions.

Erected as a Parish in: 1988

Brief History: Melvazhi, a substation under Eraiyur for long and Rita Nagar under Kallakurichy from 1959 were combined into a parish in 1988. A new church was built by Fr.D. Arockiadoss, the parish priest through the benefactors from U.S.A. organized through Fr.M.J. Bernard Dore, the first Parish Priest of Melvazhi in 2010. Our Lady of Loreto is venerated as the co-patron of the parish.







Erected as a Parish on: 19-08-2007

Brief History: It was a substation of Konankuppam parish even from the time of the famous Jesuit Missionary Fr. Beschi of the 16th Century. Later it became the substation of Kovilanur parish. A New Church was built and blessed by Archbishop Most Rev. Dr. A. Anandarayar on 25th March 2007. Ulundurpet was erected as a new parish and Rev.Fr.V.Messiah was appointed as the First Parish Priest on 19" August, 2007. Mathianur (From Kovilanur Parish), Eman, Kalavanur and Thamal (From Eraiyur parish) are made the substations of this new parish. The yearly parochial feast is celebrated on 13" January.
